As a member of Alnwick District Triathlon Club you are expected to abide by the following member's code of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions
 - All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, ability, gender, race, ethnicity, religious belief, sexuality or social/economic status
 - Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform the coach if they are going to be late
 - Members must wear appropriate kit – (cycling helmet is compulsory at all times on the public highway) – for training sessions as agreed with the coach
 - Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly
 - Members are not allowed to take any prohibited drugs or alcohol whilst participating in club activities or whilst representing the club
 - Members are encouraged to support the club with events it hosts
 - All members must follow British Triathlon and Government guidelines regarding Covid-19 and social distancing. Failure to comply during a training session will result in a warning and possible expulsion from the session. Three offences will instigate the club disciplinary process as outlined in the club constitution
