

## **Chairperson's Report 2023**

2023 has continued to offer a variety of training sessions across all disciplines for both senior and junior members. Attendance for some of these sessions continues to be on the low side which means that costs are not consistently being covered.

Whilst the club is in a healthy position financially the committee will continue to review the cost effectiveness of sessions provided, so members are encouraged to make use of the fantastic coaching resources available at these sessions, whatever the ability level.

The committee has agreed to continue the range of member benefits and discounts for 2024 which it is hoped will provide support for juniors, encourage new members to get involved in events and support coaches, activators, committee members and volunteers. Phil Rowley and Mark Hatton have continued to work with Provision to offer an expanded range of designs for club kit. It is acknowledged that there have been problems with delivery of club kit some of which is outside of Provision's control. The possibility of seeking alternative suppliers has been discussed by the committee which has agreed to accept the recommendation from Phil and Mark to continue to with Provision, building on the relationship that already exists. This position will remain under review if problems persist.

As ever, the club continues to rely on everyone who volunteers in whatever capacity to ensure the smooth running of the club. When additional volunteers are requested, all members are encouraged to consider putting themselves forward in order to spread the burden as widen as possible.

Thanks go to those committee members who are stepping down from their roles this year, their time and effort is very much appreciated.

The club will continue to review the development plan and club standards for the next 12 months to ensure that procedures are in place to keep up to date with requirements set by British Triathlon and England Athletics and that the club remains in a strong position to continue forwards.
