The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect, encouraged to be open at all times, and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with either The Chairman; Angela Barrett, Head Coach; Melanie Cumberland or Secretary; Maria Keepa .

As a member of Vale Trident's Junior Triathlon Club, you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must compete within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect fellow competitors, coaches and officials.
- All members must not take any kind of banned or illegal performance enhancing substances.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and events or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit – for training and events as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on the club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.

COVID-19 additional requirements

- Members must stay with their allocated group for training.
- Social distancing with coaches, volunteers and other members should be observed on arrival, throughout and on departure of the training sessions.
- Members should wash their hands or use hand- sanitizer before and after the session and avoid touching their faces during the session as far as possible.
- Members should inform a coach or volunteer immediately if they feel unwell during the training session. If the member is displaying any symptoms of COVID 19, they will be asked to isolate from the group until they are collected by a responsible adult.
